## Project Scope

On 11<sup>th</sup> May 2007, the Hope Vale Aboriginal Shire Council and Minister Mal Brough (Minister for Families, Community Services & Indigenous Affairs) signed the “Hope Vale Guugu Yimithirr Warra Foundations for Welfare Reform Agreement”. The agreement addresses a diverse range of issues facing the Hope Vale community.

An integral part of the agreement is the development and implementation of 200 individual Shared Responsibility Agreements addressing Pride of Place. The agreements document the mutual responsibilities of each party regarding improving tenancy arrangements and the condition of each house and yard.

The Pride of Place Shared Responsibility Agreements look at ways to improve internal and external components of houses based on the priorities of individual residents.
